Lodz, the second biggest Polish city, is situated in the centre of Poland, a green city with over 30 parks. Lodz is well known for its beautiful art nouveau and architecture. The most characteristic place in the city is Piotrkowska Street, a promenade seven kilometres long with its own remarkable style and over 100 pubs and restaurants. Along this unique street you can take pleasure in going for a ride in a rickshaw or a retro tram and admiring all the wonderful architecture. Other areas of interest is the largest building of its kind - the Poznanski Palace, where the Historical Museum of the City of Lodz is placed. Next to this Palace there is a big shopping and leisure centre – Manufaktura, based in the old factory buildings. The old buildings, now beautifully renovated, make an unforgettable impression and are very representative of the history of the city of Lodz.



Technical University of Lodz

Technical University of Lodz (TUL), the 2008 ECCA Conference hosts, belongs to the largest Polish academic centres. It was founded in 1945 and at the beginning consisted of three faculties: Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Chemistry. TUL offers more than 40 courses of study in all relevant engineering disciplines. Currently, there are over 20,000 students at TUL and 1,600 academics. TUL scientists are involved in research activities comprising of biomedical engineering, materials engineering, food technology, computer science, nanoelectronics, telecommunications and many more. TUL takes part in numerous international research programs collaborating with over 300 institutions from more than 40 countries. It is worth to mention that since 2000 a campus card system has been successfully developed at the Faculty of Electrical, Electronic, Computer and Control Engineering (EECCCE). Today, the system serves about 4,000 students and since its deployment it has significantly improved the management of teaching and research activities at the largest faculty of TUL.
