

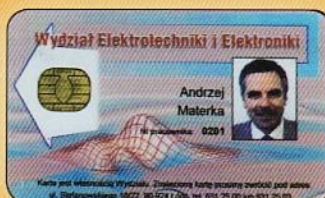

The church is popular for weddings because of its unique location. This historic landmark offers a beautiful view over the city of Linz.

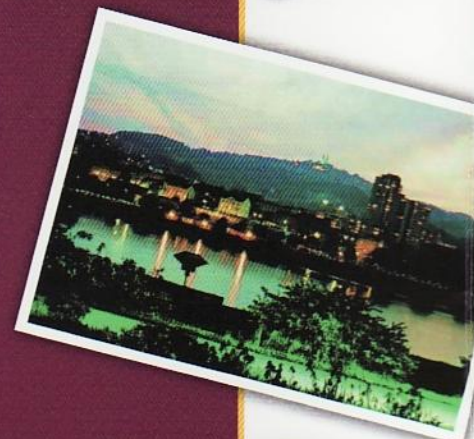
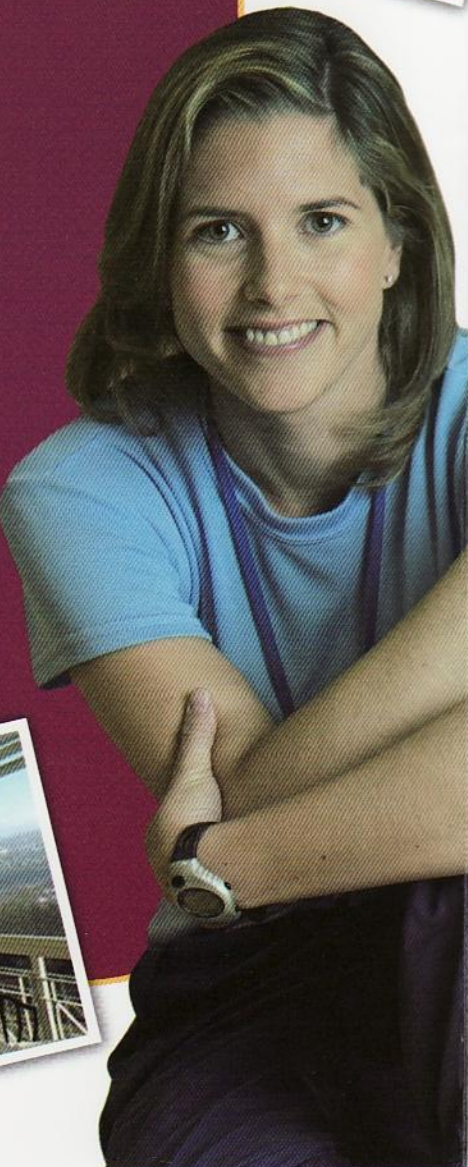
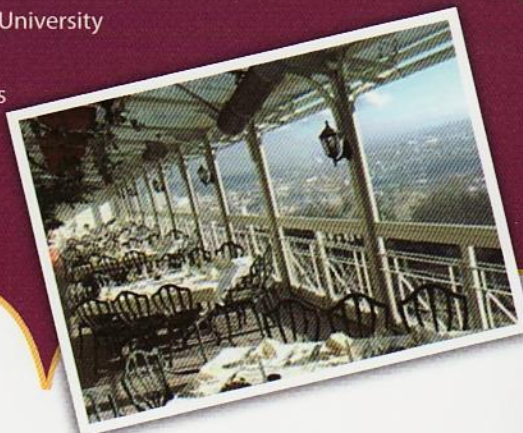
